



WEEE COMPLIANCE DECLARATION

Universal Security Systems (USS) is compliant with the WEEE Directive 2002/96/EC and the UK's WEEE Regulations. We are a member of the Valpak Producer Compliance Scheme (PCS).

- Producer Registration No. WEE/BB1798TW/PRO

USS is not a manufacturer of electronic and electrical equipment (EEE), but incurs an obligation under the WEEE Regulations when it imports EEE of the following categories: -

- Category 3a: IT & telecommunications equipment

In part fulfilment of our obligation, USS offers a free take-back service for redundant EEE where: -

- USS first put this EEE on the market after 13/08/05
- USS is selling replacement equipment of the same type that is being discarded, even if that discarded was put onto the market prior to 13/08/05

The take-back service applies to EEE equivalent only to that USS has imported.

USS operates an ISO 14001 certified environmental management system (EMS). Our controls ensure that all collected WEEE is handled in full accordance with the WEEE Regulations and other legislative requirements. Waste notes will be generated for each stage of the journey, and customers must hold a Premises Code if they produce more than 0.5 tonnes of hazardous waste/pa. It is illegal for USS to collect hazardous waste from sites that do not hold a valid Premises Code unless they are exempt.

All collected WEEE is taken to an Approved Authorised Treatment Facility (AATF) where it is treated, recycled and recovered in accordance with the WEEE Regulations. USS uses independent environmental specialists to audit this facility on an annual basis. The audit checks the facility's continued compliance to environmental legislation, and ensures both USS and its clients can be assured they are satisfying their waste management Duty of Care.
